

IIT Hyderabad retained its Top 10 in NIRF-2022 & Now becomes the Top-15 institute in the country

For the 7th consecutive year, IITH has maintained its position within the Top 10 ranks among the technical institutes in the country and as the best among the second-generation IITs.

National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), Ministry of Education, Government of India, has released the **seventh edition** of the most-awaited National Institutional rankings on July 15, 2022. IIT Hyderabad has **improved its overall NIRF Rankings from 16 in 2021 to 14 in 2022**. For the 7th consecutive year, IITH has maintained its position within the **Top 10 ranks** among the technical institutes in the country and as the **best among the second-generation IITs**. IITH has significantly improved its ranking in NIRF over the last 7 years, from **being ranked 30 to being in the Top 15**. IITH has gained ~3 points in the Research and Professional Practices & Perception and a few points improvements in other parameters. This year IITH also entered the **improved its QS World University Rankings by 10 pts** and was ranked **#7 in ARIIA 2021**. On the research & Innovation front, IITH has outperformed 1st - Gen IIT in both NIRF – 2022 & ARIIA - 2021.

Expressing his delight on this attainment, Prof B S Murty, Director, IIT Hyderabad, said, “Today, IITH is a brand of its own and is destined to attract a pool of highly talented students and faculty members to invent & innovate in technology for humanity and make IITH ‘A Dream Destination for every Academician, Researchers & Industry’. This achievement is merely due to the sheer hard work of the students, staff, faculty members, and the vision of the torch bearers of this institute and, more importantly, our alumni. I would also like to place on record our gratitude for the support of the Ministry of Education and JICA in our growth. With new and interdisciplinary academic programs that are the need of the hour and in line with the NEP-2020”.

Talking about IITH’s NIRF Journey so far, Dr Sai Santosh Kumar Raavi, Dept. of Physics & Nodal Officer, NIRF at IITH, said, “IITH is the only second-generation IIT that consistently made into the top 10 engineering institutes in the country. IITH’s score on some parameters such as faculty-student ratio, faculty qualification, financial resource utilization, patents, and footprint of projects, are comparable or higher than some of the older generation IITs.”
